I. Residential Rental Registration

State law changes regarding rental registration programs were effective in January 2017 and required the City to amend its current rental registration ordinance. The changes were initially discussed on November 7, 2016 by the Community Safety Committee(CSC). Recently, this topic was again brought to the CSC on November 15, 2018 and December 11, 2018. To conform to state law, the recommended ordinance changes include removal of the mandatory registration requirement, removal of the initial meeting fee, changing violations from criminal to civil penalties, and the addition of the right to appeal.
