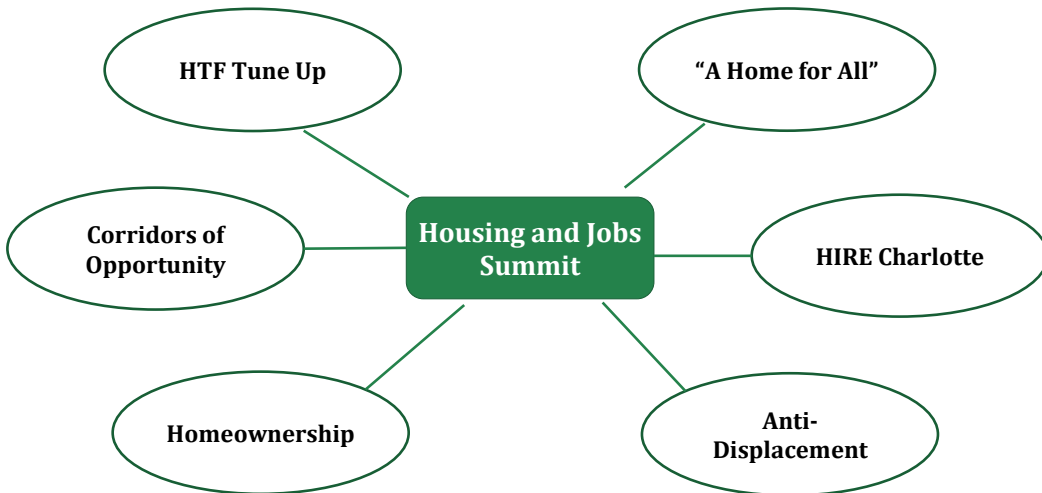

Housing & Jobs Summit [Early Thinking]

Scope	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Primary focus: <u>affordable housing</u> [access and supply] and creating/filling good <u>jobs</u> • Secondary focus: topics such as Corridors of Opportunity, small business vitality, workforce development, and anti-displacement to be incorporated as applicable
Desired Outcomes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reinforce connection between housing and jobs, as core to economic mobility • Provide forum for external stakeholder engagement/feedback • Achieve greater understanding/alignment regarding current initiatives and key gaps to be addressed
Timing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • September to November 2022 timeframe [specific date TBD]
Participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Housing ecosystem partners [e.g., DreamKey, Inlivan, LISC, Mecklenburg County] • Jobs ecosystem partners [e.g., Charlotte Works, CRBA] • Advocates / community leaders [i.e., focused on participants in recent/current city initiatives]
Format	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One day [6-8 hours total] • Balance between speeches, panel discussions, break-out sessions, etc.
Illustrative Agenda Items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High-profile keynote speaker[s] • Current state summary [what does the data tell us re: housing and jobs] • Panel discussions w/community partners [e.g., Housing; HIRE Charlotte; Minority/Small Businesses; Community Advocates] to highlight current/planned initiatives • Break-out sessions [e.g., feedback on definitions of success and outcome goals]
