➤ **District Criteria (Used in 2001 & 2011)**

- **Importance of the First Order (Highest)**

- Districts must have substantially equal population (Required)
- Districts should be reasonably compact (Strongly Recommended)
- District boundaries may follow neighborhood boundaries or the boundaries of areas containing residents sharing similar interests

- **Importance of the Second Order**

- *When possible, districts should have relatively even partisan balance*.*
- District boundaries may be drawn to create/maintain balance between major political parties.
- District boundaries may follow precinct boundaries.
- District boundaries may be drawn considering the race of district residents as long as race is not the predominant motivating factor.
- District(s) most likely to be impacted by future annexations may be smaller to minimize impact of future annexations on future re-districting.
- District boundaries may be drawn to avoid contests between incumbents.

**Only additional criteria recommended by Citizens' Advisory Committee on Governance in 2020 report.*

- **Nov 12** – Notify local Board of Elections (BOE) Whether Final Map Available by Nov 17
- **Nov 17** - Last Day to Provide Adopted Map to BOE for 2022 Elections
- **Dec 6 -17** – Filing Period for Delayed Municipal Elections
- **Mar 8, 2022** – Partisan Municipal Primary
- **Apr 26** – General Municipal Election

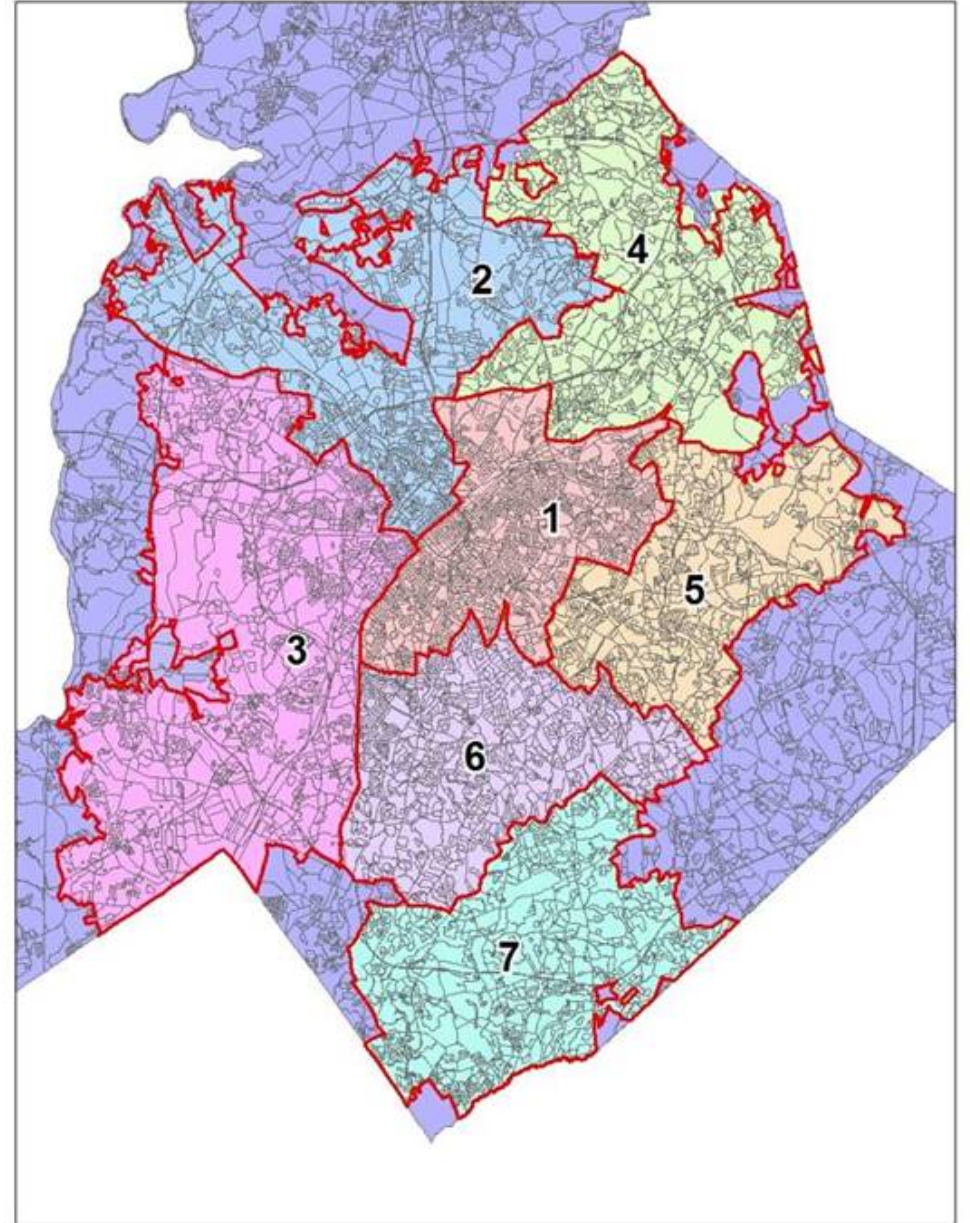
➤ City Council Dates

- **Oct 18** – Public Hearing (mandatory)
- **Nov 8** – Council Vote and Adoption of Final Map
- **Nov 15** – Fall Back/Last Possible Date for Council Vote and Adoption

- **Sep 13 & 14** – Individual Meetings with District Council Members
- **Sep 20** – Committee Meeting
- **Oct 5** – Committee Meeting (PM) to Receive Public Comment/Input on Proposed Revised Maps Under Committee Consideration
