There are 15 items to review by the September 24th CIG meeting



In order to provide good input for all the items, **each meeting will have an expert giving a presentation** on one of the larger topics with a Q&A session to follow



Members will spend the bulk of their time in Zoom breakout rooms, remaining in the same sub groups through September.



Members will spend the allotted time in their sub groups completing the sub group analysis and requesting resources or information pertaining to the topic



Facilitators will record the meetings, help by taking notes, get any information or resources the sub group may need, move along discussion, help determine who will do the sub group analysis presentation to the Safe Communities Committee



Groups will work on their assigned items during the breakout sessions and will be **strongly encouraged to continue their work offline with their fellow breakout group members**



Group members that have an interest in another topic, beyond the ones they have been assigned, **are encouraged to engage with other breakout team group members at any time outside of the meeting**



Each group will be afforded the opportunity to present their sub group analysis to the entire Community Input Group for feedback prior to submission to the Safe Communities Committee (exception made for the first week's meeting)



A designee from each group will be given 3 minutes at the Safe Communities Committee to offer an overview of their topic. Safe Communities Committee members will have been given the sub group analysis prior to the meeting. Like council meetings, presenters will be muted once their 3 minutes are up. Presenters must remain in the meeting to answer any subsequent questions that arise from committee members

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It is important to remember that the input that is offered will not automatically become policy. The group's input serves as points of reference that will help inform the decisions made by the Safe Communities Committee



When research or policy work is utilized in the creation of the sub group analysis, **we ask that it be cited appropriately**
