The city has received a request for support in the establishment of a Family Justice Center in Mecklenburg County. The Family Justice Center follows a national victim-centered, trauma-informed model in which domestic violence, sexual assault, elder abuse, human trafficking and child abuse partners are co-located and work in collaboration with each other so that victims and their children can access all of these services that they need in a single place, i.e. advocates, law enforcement, prosecutors, counselors, representatives of the faith community, healthcare providers, and others in one location.
