<p>Could we ask the FTA to allow us to use CARES funding to extend fare elimination? What would it take for us to keep fare free and 15-minute routes? Can we use COVID support funding to extend the fare free period? (Ajmera)</p>	<p>CATS is inquiring with the FTA regarding the questions pertaining to the use of CARES funding. CATS is also researching the cost to keep fare free and 15-minute routes. Follow up information will be provided to Council as available.</p>	<p>CATS</p>
<p>What is the expected timing for completion of plexiglass installation on buses? (Johnson)</p>	<p>CATS is actively in the process of procuring plexiglass shields. The contract is for the purchase and installation of the shields. The goal is to complete installation as soon as possible however, timing of installation will be dependent on availability of the shields to complete the order. It is estimated to take six months to fully complete installation.</p>	<p>CATS</p>
<p>How many CMPD officers were on the scene at the time the shooting started? (Winston)</p>	<p>CMPD officers were not on scene prior to the call for service about the person hit by the car. After approximately two minutes from the initial call for service, 12 officers were first responders to the scene and present as shots began.</p>	<p>CMPD</p>
<p>Were firefighters or medic accosted when they arrived on scene? (Egleston)</p>	<p>CMPD was assisting Medic and Firefighters as they helped victims. No CFD personnel were physically assaulted, however some staff were pushed and bumped by the crowd as they were attempting to aid injured victims.</p>	<p>CFD</p>
<p>How long did it take for police to arrive on scene in numbers that were appropriate to manage the scene? (Driggs)</p>	<p>Approximately 12 officers were on the scene in response to the call for service for a person hit by a vehicle and were on scene as gunshots were being fired. At 10 minutes into the incident, approximately 20 officers were on scene and managing the crowd.</p>	<p>CMPD</p>
