Municipal Service Districts Annual Update  (Phil Reiger)	Mayfield	Has there been a plan for the midtown district?	City Council adopted the <a href="#">Midtown Morehead Cherry Area Plan</a> in 2012 which covers half of the Municipal Services District in Midtown. The <a href="#">Elizabeth Plan</a> from 2009 that covers the remaining Municipal Services District in Midtown.
	Driggs	Has Center City Partners connected with the joint venture?	Center City Partners does not have any connections with the joint venture.
	Mayfield	Requested more information about the ambassador program.	<a href="#">Find more information on the ambassador program here.</a>
	Harlow	Is the West End expense different from the past? Is that a flat expense? Do you see more expense in the west end, going forward?	The West End expense is the same as it has been for the last three years and is a flat expense, with the exception of sponsorship money we raise for specific events and initiatives. Additional program expenses in West End over the next three years are not anticipated.
	Harlow	How can Center City Partners facilitate reducing barriers (such as I-77) in the future upon development?	Adopted plans (including the 2020 Vision Plan, 2030 Transit Plan, and other small area plans) call for pedestrian, bike, and greenway infrastructure that create connectivity between Uptown, South End and the surrounding neighborhoods. Center City Partners has also initiated and supported arts, lighting and mural solutions to bridge physical barriers (such as I-77 and I-277 bridges and overpasses).
