Rezoning Petition #2017-193 (Debra Campbell)	Ajmera	Requested clarification on existing tree save policy and how it impacts this Rezoning Petition.	<p>The tree ordinance, including tree save and street tree requirements, applies to properties within the city limits and the extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) and is administered by Urban Forestry Division (Engineering and Property Management). This division indicated there are no outstanding issues associated with the proposed rezoning.</p> <p>The City Arborist Division (Engineering and Property Management) oversees the planting, maintenance and removal of trees within street rights-of-way only within Charlotte city limits. The subject property is located outside city limits but inside the ETJ, therefore the City Arborist Division has no authority over trees within the right-of-way unless the property is annexed into the city limits.</p>

Do we have money in our community investment plan for this?	<p>This will be integrated into our zoning ordinance through the Transit Oriented Development Zoning Districts that are currently being drafted. For additional information please visit https://charlotteudo.org/about-2/transit-oriented-development.</p> <p>Our current community investment plan does not have additional funding for the South End Vision Plan. Several initial projects that are already in process have received funding through specific CIP projects allocated, including the Corridor Improvement Implementation Funds for the South Boulevard, South Tryon Street and Rail Trail improvements and the Pedestrian Rail Crossing at Rampart Street.</p>

Can you share the organizations you have already reached out to/organizations who have expressed interest?</p>	<p>Due to limited funding, we are currently limiting the maximum grant amount to \$500. Larger "capacity building" grants could be considered in the future, but would require additional funding.</p> <p>A list of organizations that we have begun working with is attached.</p>
<p>Police Crime Lab Gas Chromatograph/Mass Spectrometer</p> <p>(Chief Putney/Kim Eagle)</p>	<p>Mayfield/Lyles</p>	<p>Do we plan on buying holster monitors to supplement body cams?</p>	<p>From September - November 2017, CMPD tested 100 holsters that automatically activate body-worn cameras when an officer draws their service weapon. The test was considered a success, with a low failure rate. CMPD informed the manufacturer of recommended design improvements to further minimize the failure rate. The manufacturer expects to place this holster into production in May 2018. The cost of these holsters has not been determined.</p>
