Agenda Item #13 – Sale of City Property on West Tyvola Road

This item contains additional information for Agenda Item #13 on the February 13 Council Business Agenda, specifically follow-up responses to Council's questions on this topic during the February 6 Workshop

Why is the developer requesting a 240-day due diligence and closing period? (CM Smith)

- The due diligence period will allow the developer to determine the suitability of the property for multi-family development, pursue a rezoning of the parcel, and secure financial commitments including funding from the Housing Trust Fund.

- The closing period will be utilized to complete the design of the project followed by the permitting process with the City and Mecklenburg County.
- The projected 240 day due diligence period represents the maximum amount of time that these activities might require. The developer is eager to commence development and will do so as soon as the due diligence and closing requirements above have been achieved, shortening the time to closing if possible.

Would donating the land make the transaction more efficient or provide a substantial benefit to the project or the City? (MPT Lyles)

- No, a land donation does not make the transaction more efficient or provide a substantial benefit to the project or the City?
- Fee simple ownership is a preferred structure when private financing is also required for the project. Due to the level of affordability the developer would like to achieve, donating the land does not eliminate the need for a Housing Trust Fund request so it would not make the transaction more efficient.
- The proposed fee simple transaction at appraised value approach, allows an affordability commitment to be made along with a funding request through the Housing Trust Fund process.
- This structure utilizes current City procedure to transfer land to a third party and is currently the most efficient path to approval.

Would conveying the land through a long term ground lease be a preferred structure? (Mayor Roberts)

- No, the developer has requested a fee simple purchase of the land because conveying the land through a ground lease could limit the developer's ability to secure the necessary private financing required to make the project feasible.

Can the land sale proceeds be transferred from the General Fund to the Housing Trust Fund? (CM Smith)

- Yes, City Council could transfer the land sale proceeds from the General Fund to the Housing Trust Fund. Land sale proceeds are essentially PAYGO cash, Council has the prerogative to allocate those funds to any one-time operating or capital needs it chooses. They could use these funds to support the affordable housing program if they like, but doing so would reduce the ability to fund other traditional one-time capital needs. Council could also offer City-owned land for sale to an affordable housing developer at a reduced (below market) price as a way to subsidize the developer's project, and still allocate the reduced proceeds to the general capital program, which would similarly reduce resources available for capital investments.
- It is currently Council policy to dedicate land sale proceeds to the Community Investment Plan for one-time capital needs. Land Sale proceeds are deposited into fund balance in the Pay-As-You-Go capital fund and allocated to capital projects whenever

possible. A current example is Council approved \$1.9 million to purchase land for future fire stations in FY2017 funded with proceeds from the sale of other City-owned land.

SUBJECT: Week 1 State Legislative Report

Session Start:

The 2017 Regular Session of the General Assembly convened on Wednesday, January 11, for its one-day organizational session. Organizational issues such as administration of oaths of office to members, election of leadership, adoption of rules, and election and appointment of officers were the primary focus of the one-day session. Rep. Tim Moore (R-Cleveland) was reelected Speaker of the House and Sen. Phil Berger was reelected Senate President Pro Tempore. The full list of House and Senate leadership is attached.

The rules adopted by each chamber included 2017 bill filing deadlines and the April 27, 2017 crossover date. Crossover refers to the date by which a bill filed in one house must be received and read into the other house or the bill may not be considered further during the Session. Bill filing deadlines for each chamber are attached.

The House and Senate reconvened the session on January 25. Since reconvening, House and Senate leaders have assigned members to the various standing committees, which are attached. Committees will start meeting the week of February 6.

What You Need to Know:

Mecklenburg / Police Countywide Jurisdiction ([SB 5 – Tarte, Bishop, J. Jackson](#)) amends the 1969 local legislation (SL 1969-1170) that was one of the legal basis for the consolidation of the City and County Police Departments in 1993 and that provides the framework for Charlotte-Mecklenburg Police Department to provide law enforcement services in the unincorporated areas of the County. SB 5 adds police officers of the six towns (Cornelius, Davidson, Huntersville, Matthews, Mint Hill and Pineville) to those authorized by the Board of County Commissioners to provide law enforcement services in unincorporated areas of the County, provided that an

agreement exists to allow the exercise of this authority. SB 5 also appears to give each town council veto power over any other municipality's police forces exercising police powers in their extra-territorial jurisdictional planning areas, which is a new power to each municipality. The lead primary sponsor, Senator Tarte, stated that the legislation was requested by the County Manager so that the County could seek the lowest cost service to provide law enforcement services in the unincorporated areas of the County. Referred to Senate State and Local Government.

Repeal HB 2 ([SB 25 – J. Jackson, Bryant, McKissick](#)) would, as the title implies, repeal 2016 HB 2. Referred to Senate Rules.

Citizens Protection Act of 2017 ([HB 63 – Warren, Collins, Jordan, Adams](#)) amends the sanctuary city legislation passed in 2015 (HB 318) by adding sanctions for cities and counties that enact what are known as “sanctuary city” ordinances, resolution, policies, procedures, practices, etc. Sanctions include withholding revenues attributable from beer and wine, telecommunications, video programming and piped natural gas taxes.

Municipal Elections ([HB 64 – Warren, Conrad, Bert Jones, Collins](#)) requires that all elections for offices filled by election of the people in cities, towns, villages and special districts must be held in even-numbered years beginning in 2022.

Charlotte Firefighters Retirement System ([HB 58 – Dulin, Autry, Belk, R. Moore](#) / [SB 54 – Waddell, Tarte, Bishop](#)) is local legislation that enables the Retirement System to comply with the Voluntary Correction Program entered into with the Internal Revenue Service, by which the method for computing a firefighters final average salary is determined. The bill has no fiscal impact upon the System.
