### Clean Construction Update

At its August 26 meeting, Council referred the topic of Clean Construction to the Environment Committee. Clean Construction is a set of strategies to minimize community health impacts from diesel emissions associated with construction activities. Staff presented an overview to Environment Committee on September 16 and is continuing to research the benefits and impacts of these strategies on City construction projects.

Staff is also seeking feedback from contractors involved in City construction work. Staff has invited large and small businesses to a meeting this Friday, October 11, to discuss equipment stock and approaches to Clean Construction. Staff will share these findings with the Environment Committee at its October 21 meeting.
