Households living in a hotel/motel room who have some type of employment income can receive up to two weeks of assistance. HTF and CHOIF Update	Johnson	Is there an opportunity to get creative with housing (e.g. shipping containers)?	HNS staff has had discussions with multi-family developers and Planning staff to explore creative and cost-effective housing development options like tiny homes, modular construction, and containers. Additionally, this discussion will be included in the work of the Mayor’s recently established Housing Community Recovery Task Force, and through the work of the Great Neighborhoods Committee.
