Please note the following questions concerning the above-referenced ITB.

Questions:

- 1. On page 4, Checklist for submitting a bid, step 2, we are asked to fax Form 1 of Section 4, but I don't see a fax number on Form 1. Answered via Addenda No.1.**
- 2. Is a sample required for hydrated lime? I see samples are required for lime slurry, just checking on hydrated lime. See Addenda No. 1**
- 3. Section 4 - Chemical Descriptions -- Hydrated lime - Can they plants take deliveries of 23.50 tons per load? Yes we can take 23.5 tons**
- 4. For Item #17, Liquid Linear Phosphate, the bid lists drums or totes, do you use both package sizes? At Dukes & Vest Water Treatment Plant, only totes are used. At the other location, both package sizes are used.**
- 5. How many drums or totes does the City of Charlotte receive per delivery for Item #17? 2 totes are ordered at a time, at Vest-delivery of 3 totes.**
- 6. How soon will a response be provided after the question deadline of February 1st? When all questions are answered via pre-bid, within 48 hours, the 2nd Addenda will be issued.**
- 7. In the event of unforeseen market conditions, will price adjustments be allowed during the contract term? No price adjustments allowed during the contract term.**
- 8. During the reverse auction, will the chemicals get broken into different lots? Yes.**
- 9. P. 27, Section 2.20 states Liquidated Damages- it states there is a cost set forth in the specifications for Liquidated Damages however there was no cap stated in the bid. Can there be a cap put on the Liquidated Damages? This section has been removed from the ITB.**

Changes:

1. Revised ITB (revised as of 2.5.18), which includes delivery requirements for McAlpine WWTP, changes in requirements for Ferric Chloride (#18)
2. Section 2.20. Liquidated Damages, has been removed.
3. **Lime Slurry jar samples and COAs are due February 12, 2018** (not February 26, 2018) at McDowell WWTP per section 3.5 of the ITB.
4. In order to participate in the jar testing and possible full trials at McDowell WWTP, your Company must be a registered vendor with the City of Charlotte.
