CROSS CHARLOTTE TRAIL - BRANDYWINE ROAD TO TYVOLA ROAD

This notification is given of the City of Charlotte's intent to acquire rights of entry for the construction of a 1.5-mile segment of the Cross Charlotte Trail, a hard-surface greenway along Little Sugar Creek from north of Brandywine Road near Westfield Drive to north of Tyvola Road. Property owners affected by the Cross Charlotte Trail - Brandywine Road to Tyvola Road project have been notified by mail, and easement acquisitions are in negotiation stages with the respective property owners.

The public is hereby notified of the proposed trail project and of the intent of the City to acquire rights of entry on the following Mecklenburg County-owned properties, which were acquired with Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funding:
