

Stevens Creek Phase 2 Wastewater Project (Dressage Boulevard to Bretton Woods Drive)



Charlotte Water (CLTWater) installed a new wastewater pipe to enhance service to neighborhoods along Stevens Creek between Dressage Boulevard and Bretton Woods Drive. All construction and restoration by CLTWater contractors includes a one year warranty.

RESTORATION ACTIVITIES TO EXPECT:

- Seeding area with annual ryegrass
- Applying straw mulch
- Installing permanent fencing that was removed during construction
- Restoring creek banks
- Paving the trenched area of Joli Cheval Lane and Hollow Oak Drive

Manholes are installed flush with grass if in a maintained yard. If the manhole is installed in a floodplain, it may have a vent coming out of it or may be raised.

CLTWater has additional projects planned to expand the availability of public wastewater service. These projects will assist properties that do not currently have access to public service and may have failing septic systems or are properties that are unable to be served by private septic tanks. These projects also eliminated a small package wastewater treatment plant facility (Oxford Glen) and two neighborhood lift stations which will improve system reliability and reduce ongoing maintenance costs.

Stevens Creek (Phase 2) Wastewater Project Update

Crews completed wastewater pipe installation and are working on restoration.
