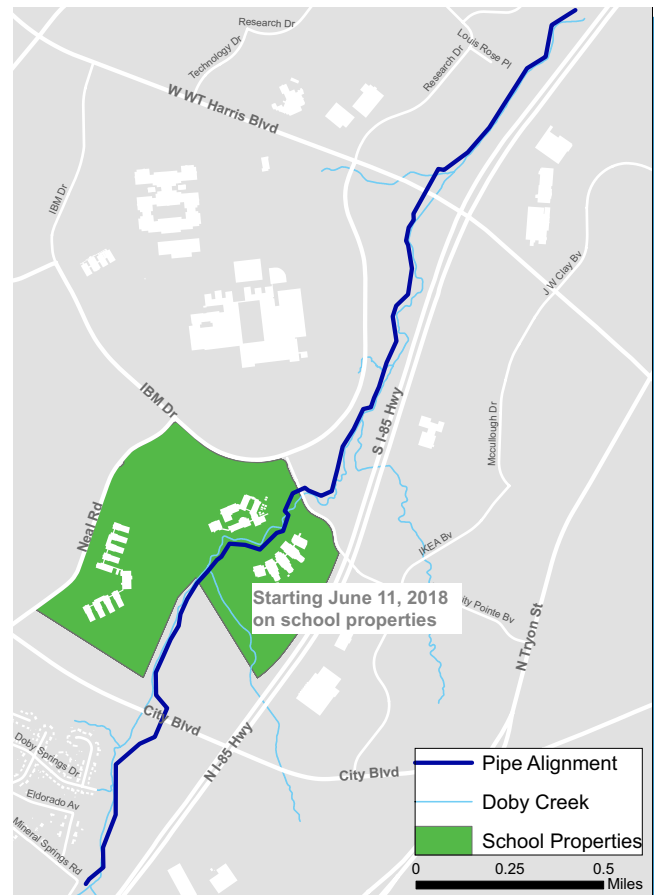

# Wastewater Improvements Coming Soon

- WHAT:** BRS Inc., under Charlotte Water's supervision, will install a new wastewater pipe to serve customers in the Doby Creek area.
- WHEN:** Construction will start on public school property soon after the school year ends.
- WHERE:** Pipe alignment in construction easements (see map).
- WHAT TO EXPECT**
- **Tunneling bore pits** - Crews will tunnel under major roads.
  - **Clearing** – Trees, shrubs, bushes and other vegetation within the construction easement area will be removed. Tree stumps will be removed and holes filled. Debris will be transported off site. When and where possible, trees are preserved.
  - **Pipe delivery and storage** – Pipe is delivered and stored within the construction easements.
  - **Establishing a safe work zone** – Fencing will be put in place and pipe will be stabilized to prevent it from moving.
  - **Trench digging** (five to twenty-foot deep)
  - **Placing pipe and backfilling**
  - **Customers May Feel a Rumble**  
Crews may remove rock formations by use of small blasting. Blasting is a standard construction procedure in which holes are drilled into the rock for dynamite placement and covered with heavy mats. Residents may hear a warning horn, a muffled noise, and slight vibration or rumble similar to a slammed door or thunder. The area will be monitored with seismographs to gauge earth vibration levels as required.
  - **Construction traffic** (excavators, dump trucks) along the creek, within the easements or road right-of-way.
