Drinking Water Improvement Project

Starting mid-May, Charlotte Water (CLTWater) and contractor C&D Utility will start construction to replace existing water pipes serving Flamingo Avenue from Shamrock Drive to Springway Drive. The project will take two months to complete.

During Construction

Construction can be loud, dirty and inconvenient. Crews will be using heavy equipment and storing materials on-site. Construction will take place in and beside the roadway within the right-of-way. Please be aware of your surroundings near the construction site and report any safety concerns to the project inspector as soon as possible.

Property Access (Driveway)

Construction activities will take place within the street right-of-way. However, driveway and sidewalk access may be limited at times. If you need assistance, please talk to contractor or call project inspector. Please alert us to invisible fence, irrigation systems, and other underground improvements to your home near the street.

Lane Closures and Street Parking

Street Parking may be restricted when construction is in the immediate area. Flaggers will help drivers navigate around any lane closures.

Water Outages

In the unexpected event of a water service interruption, the issue will be treated as an emergency and repairs will be made to restore service as quickly as possible. Customers will be notified several days in advance of any planned water outages.

Flowing Hydrants

Residents may see water flowing from hydrants as part of construction activities.
