Wastewater Improvements Update

Charlotte Water (CLTWater) are installing a new wastewater pipe to serve customers in the Four Mile Creek area. Construction can be loud, dirty and inconvenient. Crews are using heavy equipment and storing materials on-site. Please be aware of your surroundings near the construction site and report any safety concerns to the project inspector as soon as possible.

CURRENT STATUS:

- Pipe and manhole installation is occurring between Weddington Road and Winterbrooke Drive.
- The majority of blasting is complete.

NEXT STEPS:

June - Mid-August

Most construction activities will be between Winterbrooke Drive and Bumble Bee Drive.

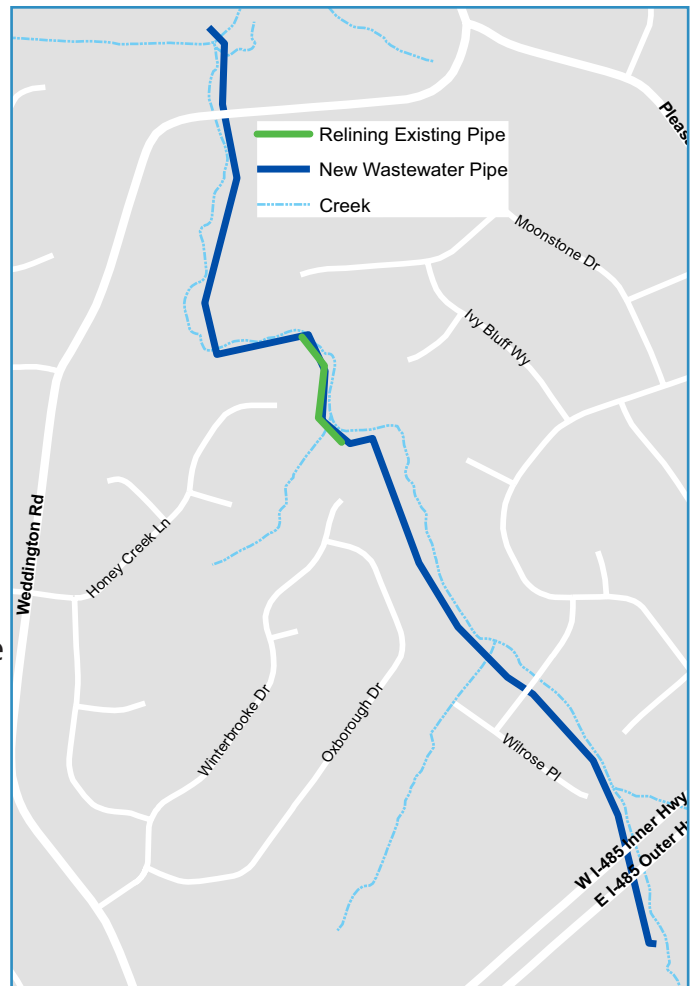
A second crew will install wastewater pipe under I-485. Customers on Fair Forest Drive and Wilrose Place may begin to see construction vehicles accessing the easement.

Crews will install an interior liner in the existing pipe from manhole #5 to manhole #9 (see green line on map). The majority of this work will be at 2300 Winterbrooke Drive. Customers in the immediate area will receive additional information in advance of this work.

On several occasions this summer, crews may need to work starting at 4:00 am or as late as 11:00 p.m. Crews need the cool temperatures to spray the interior lining of manholes. Crews will be mindful of their surroundings and minimize noises. We will inform customers adjacent to the activity beforehand.

Mid-July - end of August

Expect to see more construction activities between Bumble Bee Drive and Fair Forest Drive.
