

# WASTEWATER PIPE REPLACEMENT UPDATE

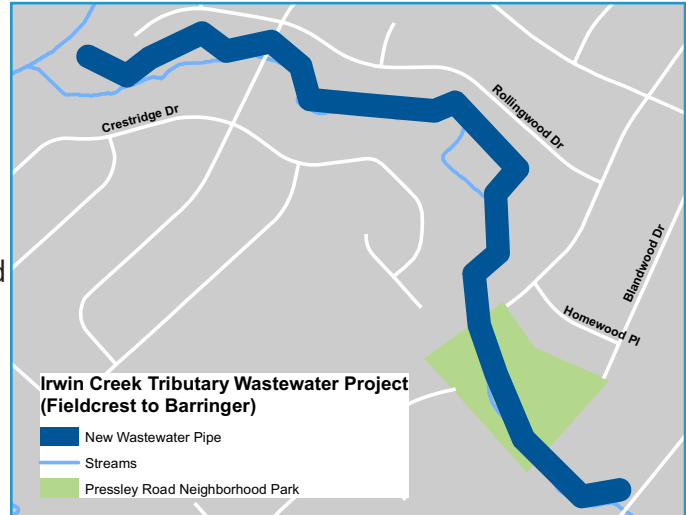


Charlotte Water is planning to install a new wastewater pipe to serve Fieldcrest Road to Barringer Drive area. Construction will start October 2018 and last at least nine months. This project will replace an existing pipe with a larger pipe to minimize the risk of wastewater spills and accommodate future needs.

What to expect:

1. Clearing – Trees, shrubs, bushes and other vegetation within the construction easement area will be removed. Tree stumps will be removed and holes filled. Debris will be transported off site.
2. Pipe delivery and storage – Pipe is delivered and stored within the construction easements along the creek.
3. Establishing a safe work zone – Fencing will be put in place and pipe will be stabilized to prevent it from moving.
4. Trench digging
5. Placing pipe and backfilling
6. Construction traffic (excavators, dump trucks) along the creek, within the easements or road right-of-way.

Charlotte Water will be replacing wastewater pipes along Irwin Creek Tributary near Fieldcrest Road and Barringer Drive.

You will be notified in advance of any activity on your property. Easement acquisition is ongoing for the project and you will be contacted if an easement is required on your property.



Crews will dig mostly along utility easements. Pipe and other materials will be along construction zone.
