Dear Customer:

Charlotte Water (CLWater) notified you in 2018 about plans to enhance the wastewater pipe network along McDowell Creek.

**Project Status:**

- The project is on hold.
- The design is complete.

**Next Steps:**

- Real estate acquisition will begin in 2020.
  - Most of the land is owned by Mecklenburg County.
  - Private property owners will be contacted.
- Cleaning and inspecting the existing pipes may occur between now and 2025.
- Construction would begin in 2025 or later.

**Project Goals**  
20,000 linear feet of 66-inch diameter pipe from wastewater treatment plant to the confluence of Torrence and McDowell Creeks.  
4,600 linear feet of 48-inch sewer from the end of the 66-inch to where the Lower McDowell/Torrence Creek Greenway meets Torrence Creek.  
5,400 linear feet of 24-inch sewer from the end of the 48-inch to just north of Rosewood Meadow Lane.
