McMullen Creek Tributary to Quail Hollow Wastewater Improvements Project Update

WHAT: Contractors for Charlotte Water, led by Atlantic Coast Contractors, will continue construction on Phase 2 of the McMullen Creek Tributary to Quail Hollow Wastewater Improvements project. The project, which began in April, takes place in construction easements – including on Quail Hollow Club – public rights-of-way and streets, and it consists of repairing and replacing existing pipe segments and rehabilitating manholes.

WHEN/WHERE: Construction will continue this fall and is ongoing until spring 2022, with varying levels of activity. Specific activity schedules include:

- A.** Pipe replacement along the northern Seven Eagles neighborhood (from intersection of Seven Eagles and Eagle Glen up to Gleneagles Road) – September through October.
- B.** Pipe repairs on the Quail Hollow Club golf course near Baltusrol Lane – mid-September for 7-10 days. This work will occur during both day and night, varying throughout the week.
- C.** Creek bank restoration along the Heydon Hall neighborhood – mid-October through mid- December.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

Clearing – Crews will clear trees, bushes and shrubs along the easements following McMullen Creek tributaries as needed.

Moving equipment on site – Crews will move construction equipment and materials to easements along the project site throughout construction.

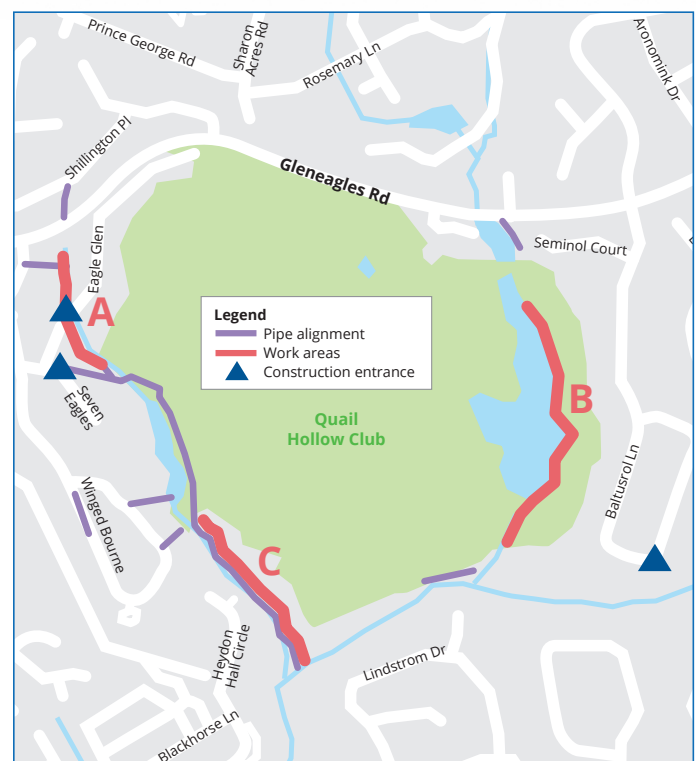
Materials delivery and storage – Pipe and other construction materials are delivered and stored within the construction easements.

Construction traffic and loud machinery – Construction vehicles will travel along the alignment, within the easements and roadway, entering the work site through temporary construction entrances.

Worksite lighting as needed – In mid-September for 7-10 days, crews will use worksite lighting to illuminate the work area from dusk to dawn on the eastern side of the golf course (see *B on map*).

Continuation of service – No disruption to water or wastewater service is expected during this work.

NEXT STEPS: All work within the phase 2 area is expected to be completed by April 2022, although customers will see varying levels of activity based on their location. Please note that construction schedules are subject to change, due to weather and other conditions. Throughout construction, notifications will be mailed to residents about progress.
