The project limits are along North Tryon Street from Dalton Avenue to 30th Street. Goals for the project include infrastructure improvements that support redevelopment and improve the aesthetics of North Tryon Street and Church Street. The project will improve all modes of transportation and provide a safe pedestrian/bicycle environment. Project amenities will include crosswalks, sidewalks, planting strips, decorative lighting and bicycle lanes.
