This project will install crosswalks, sidewalks, planting strips, decorative lighting, bike lanes, public art and landscaping along North Tryon Street (from Dalton Avenue to 30th Street) and Church Street (from 23rd to 29th Street). Once completed, North Tryon will be one-way inbound on Church Street and two lanes outbound on North Tryon creating new connections.

Intermittent lane closures may be necessary but not during peak hours, 7-9 a.m. and 4-6 p.m. Our goal is to ensure the safety of workers and commuters while maintaining access to neighborhoods and businesses.
