



## Oakdale Road Farm to Market Project

### *Building Value for Charlotte*

Farm-to-Market roads are identified in the Transportation Action Plan as being generally deficient in their ability to adequately serve the rapidly developing urban land uses surrounding them.

The Oakdale Road Farm-to-Market project will upgrade Oakdale Road, from Old Plank Road to just north of Dale Avenue, to urban street standards to improve safety and traffic flow.

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## Oakdale Road Farm to Market Project

The relocation of utilities is still underway and necessary prior to constructing planned roadway improvements. Overhead utilities will be relocated on Oakdale Road from Old Plank Road to just north of Dale Avenue and will include setting new poles, installing new cable and fiber and removing old poles within the acquired right-of-way and easements.

The relocation of overhead and underground utility lines can be lengthy, due to the complicated nature of the work, and must be completed by the utility companies ahead of street construction work. We will continue to keep you informed of utility work progress.

This project will improve travel conditions for vehicles, pedestrians and bicyclists on Oakdale Road from Old Plank Road to just north of Dale Avenue. Project improvements will include a two-lane roadway with center median/turn lane, bicycle lanes, curb and gutter, planting strips, sidewalks, street trees and lighting. Following construction, a traffic signal will be installed at the intersection of Oakdale Road and Peachtree Road.
