Welcome to the Public Meeting

Charlotte Police Department: Freedom Division, 4150 Wilkinson Blvd, Charlotte, NC 28208



Tonight's meeting is an important part of the City of Charlotte's commitment to keeping the public informed. The purpose of this meeting is to present the proposed improvements to the public. Improvements include replacing the insufficient roadway bridge on Morris Field Drive with a new bridge designed for vehicles, pedestrians, and personal transportation use.

Project Overview

The City of Charlotte, in cooperation with the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT), is proposing to replace the Morris Field Drive Bridge, which spans the Norfolk Southern Railroad Tracks. The bridge, which has reached the end of its functional life, will be replaced with a structure that will service both cars and pedestrians. The design is to include bike lanes, bike buffers, sidewalks, and two travel lanes. The project is listed in the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) as B-5931.

Project Goals

- To construct a bridge that accommodates multiple modes of transportation.
- To provide bike lanes and sidewalks while continuing the level of service provided along the rest of the roadway.
- To provide buffers to allow more separation between motorists and nonmotorists.

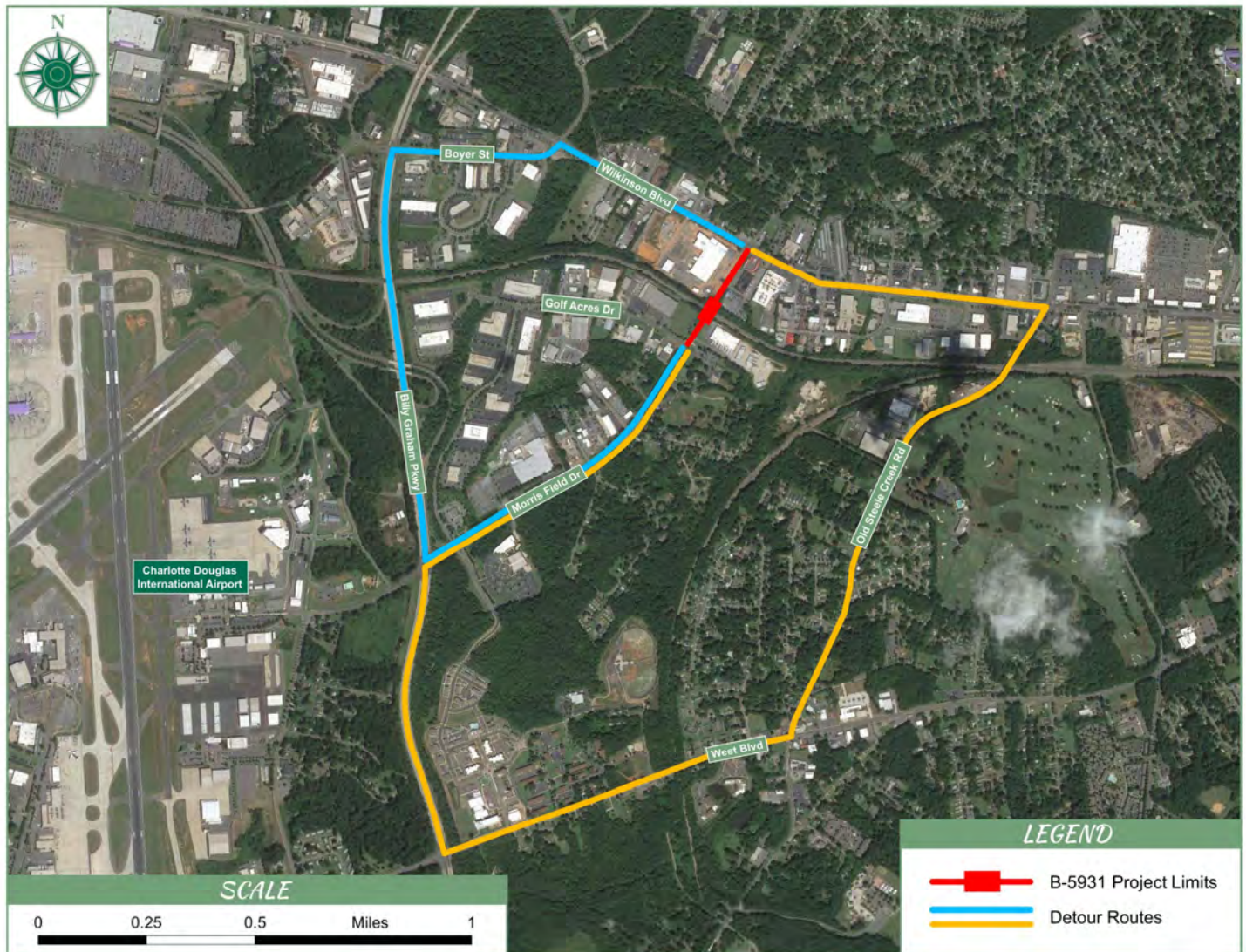

Project Alternative

The proposed alternative includes two 11-foot travel lanes, 3-foot bike buffers, 5-foot bike lanes, and 7-foot sidewalks. The roadway over the railroad will likely need to be closed during construction (12 to 18 months) and will utilize off-site detour routes as shown below.

Next Steps

After the comment period ends on **November 7, 2018**, the project team will meet to review the comments received and determine what modifications should be made to the proposed alternative.
