

East Forest Neighborhood Improvement Project

Public meeting results

The second public meeting for the East Forest Neighborhood Improvement Project (NIP) was held November 15, 2007 at Garr Memorial Church on Wallace Road. The City's consultant, Armstrong Glen, presented the comments collected from the first public meeting and three project alternatives for neighborhood improvements. The alternatives are listed below.

Alternate 1:

- Five-foot wide sidewalk on one side of Coatbridge Lane, McLaughlin Drive, Woodberry Road, Summerhill Drive, Candis Drive, and a portion of Knell Drive, Old Post Road and Lumarka Drive.

Alternate 2:

- Five-foot wide sidewalk on one side of Coatbridge Lane, Knickerbocker Drive, McLaughlin Drive, Woodberry Road, Summerhill Drive, and a portion of Old Post Road and Lumarka Drive.

Alternate 3:

- Five-foot wide sidewalk on one side of Coatbridge Lane, Knickerbocker Drive, McLaughlin Drive, Bainbridge Road, and a portion of Knell Drive, Eaglewood Avenue, Pineborough Road, and Lumarka Drive.

Based on the input we received at the meeting, a majority of residents favored Alternate 3. Since the meeting, the City has received further positive input for Alternate 3 by phone and neighborhood association websites.

What's next

The City will continue to adjust Alternate 3 in the following months to meet the most needs of the area. We welcome your input as we complete the planning phase. The third public meeting will be held in February 2008. The final plan will be presented at this meeting. Invitations will be sent two weeks prior to the meeting.
