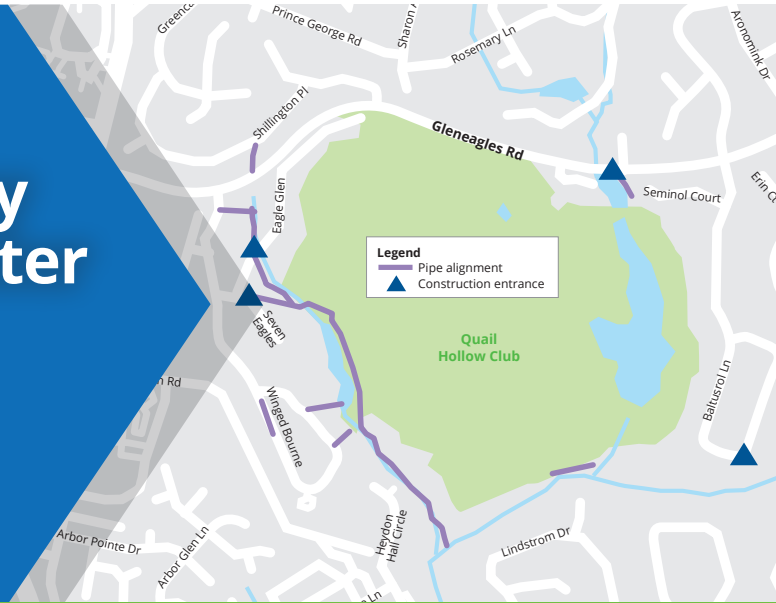


# McMullen Creek Tributary to Quail Hollow Wastewater System Improvements: Phase 2

## You're invited to a virtual public meeting to learn more about upcoming construction work for wastewater system improvements in your area.

Contractors for Charlotte Water, led by Atlantic Coast Contractors, will begin construction for Phase 2 of the McMullen Creek Tributary to Quail Hollow Wastewater System Improvements in June, with some preconstruction activities beginning in April. **Phase 2 follows McMullen Creek tributaries, with the majority of the work occurring along the west side of Quail Hollow Club (see map).** Once completed, the project will enhance the wastewater system in the community and protect the water quality in the creek.

This public information meeting is for residents surrounding Quail Hollow Club, including Seven Eagles, Heydon Hall, Ballantyne Court and Baltusrol Lane. During the virtual presentation, project representatives will share more details about the wastewater system capacity needs, proposed plans and construction activities. Participants will be able to submit questions during the WebEx Event, which will be addressed during the meeting's Q&A.
