The real estate phase is now underway. This phase involves acquiring the property rights needed to build and maintain the improvements identified during the design phase. Affected property owners will be contacted by an agent. With federally funded projects such as this, it is typical for the process to take a year or more. The project should enter the bid phase in early 2020, when the City will conduct a competitive bidding process to procure the services of contractors to build the project. Construction should begin during late summer or fall 2020.
