Roswell Avenue Street Closure #3 Notice:

(from Sterling Rd. to Queens Rd. West) Monday, May 14th, thru Friday, May 18th, 2018

Charlotte Water is obligated to provide potable water and sanitary sewer services throughout Mecklenburg County. To maintain water quality and system integrity, water and sewer mains must occasionally be replaced.

Dallas 1, under contract with CLT Water, is working to complete construction of replacement water mains, services transfers, and abandonment of old water mains, in the area around Myers Park Country Club, at Roswell Ave. and Queens Rd. West over the next few weeks.

The Contractor will abandon an old water main along Roswell Ave. and make final connections to the existing water main at Roswell Ave. and Queens Rd. West, Monday, May 14th through Friday, May 18th. To expedite work, street closure will occur on:

Roswell Avenue (#3)

from Sterling Rd. to Queens Rd. West Monday, May 14th, thru Friday, May 18th, 2018

Local Traffic Only access provided at Sterling Rd along Roswell Ave

The five-day duration is a reasonable expectation of the timeframe in which the work, with street closure, can be accomplished. It doesn't allow for inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances. Work will continue until complete, as soon as circumstances and weather permit. Detour (see maps): Thru-traffic will be detoured to Selwyn Ave. There are multiple alternate routes; however, there is only one signalized intersection where Queens Rd. West crosses Selwyn Ave. Access to Myers Park Country Club and local residences will be possible along Roswell at Sterling Rd. during Closure #3. Re-opening of the street will occur during the evenings at 4 PM.

CMS and nearby CATS bus routes may be affected. The intent of street closure is to make the work zone as safe as possible, while expediting the work. Drivers are encouraged to select alternate routes around the work zone during this time.
