The Tuckaseegee/Berryhill/Thrift Road Roundabout Project is currently in the design phase. The City appreciates your participation and input received at the two public meetings held in 2013. City staff will hold a third public meeting to present the preliminary design plans later this year. The City will notify you a few weeks in advance of the meeting.

The project goals are to improve safety and reduce vehicle idling time at the intersection, which improves air quality. The project limits include the 5-legged intersection where Tuckaseegee Road and Berryhill Road have two legs and Thrift Road has one leg. Improvements being considered for the project include crosswalks, new sidewalks, planting strips, landscaping and decorative lighting.

City staff will continue to keep you informed on the status of this project.
