The Project Team for the Tuckaseegee/Berryhill/Thrift Road Roundabout Project has scheduled an August 22 public meeting to hear your feedback. The project goals are to improve safety and reduce vehicle idling time at the intersection, which improves air quality. The project limits include the 5-legged intersection where Tuckaseegee Road and Berryhill Road have two legs and Thrift Road has one leg. Improvements being considered for the project include crosswalks, new sidewalks, planting strips, landscaping and decorative lighting.
