Wastewater Pipe Improvements

WHAT: Charlotte Water is planning to install a new wastewater pipe to serve neighborhoods along Upper Taggart Creek between Morris Field Drive and Carlyle Drive. Construction will start fall 2019.

- The project will add more than 10,000 feet of wastewater pipe to serve neighborhoods along McAlpine Creek.
- Morris Field Drive and Wilkinson Boulevard will be tunneled under.
- When finished the project will enhance pipe performance, provide increased wastewater capacity for current and future customers and protect the water quality of Upper Taggart Creek.
- CLTWater user fees (i.e. water bill) fund these improvement projects.

WHEN: Fall 2019 through 2022

WHERE: Construction of the new pipe will occur in construction easements along Upper Taggart Creek. CLTWater is acquiring easements from property owners beside creek.
