Charlotte Water (CLTWater) will start upgrading the Vest Water Treatment Plant starting in May.

- Construction start: May 2019
- Construction completion: Mid-2021
- All the improvements are inside the property fence.
- The parking lot, at the corner of Beatties Ford Road and Oaklawn Avenue, will be closed as part of the construction project.
- Normal work hours: 7:00 am – 7:00 pm, Monday through Friday.
- The contractor will work nights and weekends only as needed.
