Dear Resident or Business Owner:

On July 8, 2019, the City of Charlotte awarded a contract to Blythe Development for the construction of the Cross-Charlotte Trail-Brandywine Rd. to Tyvola Rd. This project will include new greenway construction, sidewalks, wheelchair ramps, concrete driveway replacement, piping, landscaping and asphalt pavement repairs. Affected streets include Selwyn Ave, Park Rd, Buckingham Dr., Woodland Rd, Brandywine Rd., and Westfield Rd. All work will be performed within the right of way and acquired construction easements.

Work will begin November 25, 2019 or thereafter. The contractor's staff, along with the City's Engineering Service's staff will make every effort to minimize problems and inconveniences during construction of the project. Enclosed is a brochure entitled "Under Construction" which will help you understand what you should expect during the project construction.
