Storm Drainage Improvement Project

Dear Resident,

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and engineering consultant HDR Engineering Inc. of the Carolinas are working on the design plans for the 6th and Graham Storm Drainage Improvement Project. These plans are currently under review by Norfolk Southern Railroad. When this review is complete, HDR will prepare the preliminary design plans and a public meeting will be held.

The repair project for the storm drainage system on 6th Street between North Church and North Poplar Streets is in final design. The bid phase is expected to start in early 2020. During this phase, a competitive bidding process is held to select a qualified contractor to construct the project. By state law, the lowest responsible bidder is awarded the construction contract. Once City Council awards the contract, construction will begin. Property owners who are directly affected by the work will be contacted individually prior to the start of construction.
