Project Status

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and engineering consultant HDR Engineering Inc. of the Carolinas (HDR) have started the design phase.

- HDR is developing conceptual design plans for the project. These will be provided to Norfolk Southern Railroad for review and input concerning railroad right-of-way impacts. The railroad review and input process is expected to be complete by fall 2019.
- HDR is also working on design plans to repair the pipe system failure at the corner of 6th Street and Church Street. The design process for the repair is expected to be complete by summer 2019. Property owners who are directly affected by the repair will be contacted individually in the fall.
