

Public Meeting Minutes



6th and Graham Storm Drainage Improvement Project

May 2, 2018



Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services held its first public meeting on March 27 at Mt. Moriah Primitive Baptist Church to present the recommended design alternative.

Meeting Highlights

- Due to the low attendance at the public meeting the two Project Managers, Danee McGee and Patrick Blandford, talked directly with attendees and gave a limited presentation.
- Patrick Blandford explained which properties were flooding and that a primary reason for this project was the property at 6th and Pine.
- Danee McGee explained the downstream system was analyzed to ensure the project does not adversely affect the existing downstream conditions.
- Danee also stated that the Elmwood Cemetery entrance structure will be replaced, and moved towards the railroad by a few feet in order to preserve a nearby Burr Oak for the Cemetery arboretum.
- The residents were informed that if they ever have stormwater related issues, they can call 311 to report the problem.
