Project Status

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and WK Dickson & Co., Inc. have acquired all needed construction easements. Design is being finalized and necessary environmental permits are being acquired.

Project management has been transferred to Brian Wilson.

Next Steps

Next is the bid phase, during which final plans are circulated to qualified contractors for competitive bidding, with the lowest responsible bidder awarded the construction contract. The bid phase typically lasts six to seven months, with construction to begin afterward.
