## Storm Drainage Improvement Project

August 2018



Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services is ready to begin construction. Blythe Development Company was awarded the contract on April 23. Inspection services will be provided by Gavel & Dorn Engineering. Construction is expected to begin September 4 and is estimated to be complete in two years. Additional time may be needed for weather, unforeseen circumstances, and to establish vegetation during the appropriate season.



Construction is expected to start at the Amity Place culvert and downstream of Eaglecrest Road and Aspendale Lane. Work includes:

- Clear construction easements to relocate utilities and perform stream improvements.
- Close Amity Place at the culvert to install a new culvert. Road closure is planned for late September and will be closed about three months. The contractor will maintain access to the neighborhood, with signs assisting motorists. A construction inspector will be on site daily to address any questions or concerns.
