

Cedars East



Storm Drainage Improvement Project

July 2019



Work continues on the Cedars East Storm Drainage Improvement project. Construction began in September 2018 and is estimated to take two years.

Construction Highlights

- Amity Place triple box culvert installation and upstream channel areas are complete.
- Utility relocation between Amity Place and Eaglecrest Road is in progress.
- Beginning July 29, a road closure will be necessary on Eaglecrest Road to install sanitary sewer improvements. Eaglecrest Road between Pinemont Lane and Aspendale Lane will be closed for approximately one month. Motorists should detour using Reddman Road and Amity Place.
- After the sanitary sewer installation is complete, a new 12' X 8' box culvert will be installed on Eaglecrest Road with a second road closure lasting about three months.
- The contractor will maintain access to the neighborhood, with temporary traffic signage directing motorists around the work zones. Construction signs will alert citizens, however, motorists should expect delays.
- Gavel & Dorn Engineering will be on site daily. Please contact Chris Patterson to address construction-related issues and concerns that need attention.



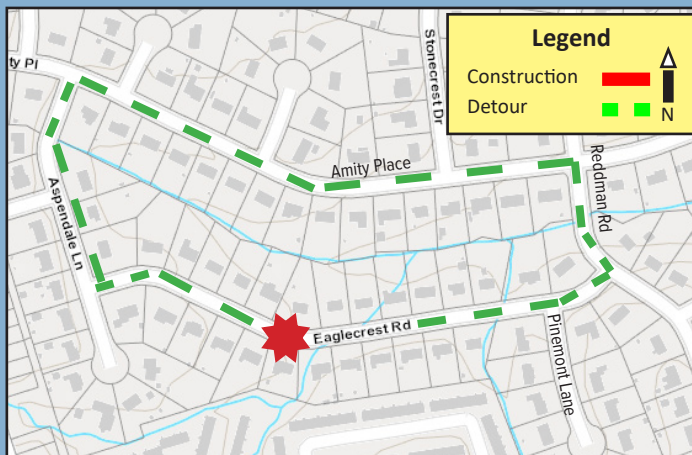
