Project update:

- Project team has reviewed customer complaints and questionnaire responses.
- Preliminary analysis has been performed on the existing storm drainage infrastructure to determine problem areas.
- Existing conditions study has been submitted and comments are being addressed.
- Analysis is ongoing to address additional review questions.

- Once the report has been resubmitted, results of the study will be shared with the neighborhood for feedback.

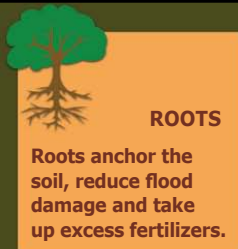
