Project Status:

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services, along with new consulting engineer, The Isaacs Group, continue with the planning phase. As part of its effort to assume the project, The Isaacs Group will complete some work to reconfirm some of the elements prepared by the previous consultant. This will take some additional survey work needed to obtain additional precision. As a result, survey crews from The Isaacs Group will be present in the neighborhood February through May. While state law authorizes access to private property for this purpose, no buildings or structures will be entered or disturbed. Once the additional information is obtained The Isaacs group will continue with development of potential alternatives to address flooding and storm water concerns.
