



### **Project Status**

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services has hired consultant Hazen and Sawyer and their surveyor Survey and Mapping Control, Inc. to study possible improvements to the storm drainage system in the Elvis project area. Representatives may need to enter your property to collect survey data on the existing storm drainage system. While state law authorizes this access to private property, no building or structures will be entered or disturbed. The survey work is scheduled to begin in December and will take approximately two weeks to complete.
