Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and engineering consultant, Parsons Brinckerhoff Inc., have finalized the construction plans and documents and begun the bid phase. During this phase, the final design plans will be circulated to qualified contractors for a competitive bidding process.

Next Steps

After City Council approval, the construction contract is awarded to the lowest responsible bidder. The bid phase typically lasts six to nine months.
