



### *Project Status*

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and engineering consultant W.K. Dickson are completing the easement acquisition phase. The final design phase started earlier this month with project team members reviewing the construction documents.

There is currently a storm drainage pipe failure at the intersection of Malvern Drive and Beverly Road. Construction is expected to start the first week of September. The road may be blocked for a short time until the repair is complete.

### *Next Steps*

Bid phase is scheduled to begin later this year. During this phase, the final plans will be circulated to qualified contractors for a competitive bidding process. The bid phase typically lasts seven to eight months. Once City Council awards the contract, construction will begin.
