Dear Resident,

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services held a public meeting on May 12 at Roof with a View to review the preferred design alternative within the Hill Street Storm Drainage Improvement Project.

Meeting highlights:

- Storm Water Services provided a summary of items that do and do not qualify for service, the difference between public and private stormwater goals and the components of the stormwater program.
- The project consultant, Dewberry provided an explanation of the Hill Street project. The project selection was based upon citizen input from 311 requests, significance in flooding, deteriorating infrastructure, and larger watershed-wide drainage issues.

- A brief overview of the existing conditions, the City design standards and the selected alternative analysis were provided.
- The proposed selected design alternative provided for new pipe system and inlets to capture the storm water runoff and transfer it into the underground pipe system before it causes flooding issues. The intent is for the new storm pipe to be placed in the right-of ways and moved from the private properties.
