

Public Meeting Minutes



Hinsdale/Tinkerbell Storm Drainage Improvement Project

November 27, 2017



Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services held its third public meeting on October 24 at Church at Charlotte to present the proposed improvements and begin the easement acquisition phase.

Meeting highlights

- John Keene introduced the project team, explained design progress and the beginning of the easement acquisition process.
- Russell Parker, Armstrong Glen Project Engineer, presented the existing conditions and recommended improvements.
- Representatives from TELICS or Michael Ryan Realty will contact affected property owners.

Resident concerns

- *Noise and work hours* - a City inspector will be on-site to ensure the contractor does not violate the City's noise ordinance.
- *Existing utilities* - proposed work has been coordinated with the private utilities, but sometimes utilities are accidentally impacted. If this happens, staff will work with the impacted utility to restore service as soon as possible. For planned utility interruptions, residents will be notified ahead of time.
- *Tree removal* - the City will do its best to minimize tree removal.
- *Storage shed removal* - the contractor will need to move several storage sheds outside the easement areas.
