Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and engineering consultant, Armstrong Glen, P.C., continue with the design phase of the Kenilworth/Romany Storm Drainage Improvement Project. The project boundaries are East Boulevard to the southwest, Euclid Avenue to the northwest, Berkeley Avenue and East Morehead Street to the northeast and Upper Little Sugar Creek to the southeast. The project goal is to reduce street and structure flooding by improving storm drainage infrastructure.

Project update includes:

- Staff is working with utility companies to resolve potential conflicts and concerns.
- Armstrong Glen is working on preliminary design plans for City Staff review.

- A public meeting is tentatively planned for spring/early summer 2014 to share the design details and request feedback as it relates to your property and the neighborhood.

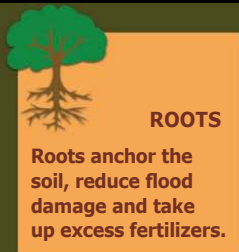
