Project Status

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and engineering consultant Dewberry Engineers have acquired all easements and environmental permits needed for construction. The project is currently in the bid phase. During this phase the final plans are circulated to qualified contractors for a competitive bidding process. Staff anticipates City Council awarding the contract to the lowest responsible bidder in May. Once the contract is awarded, construction will begin.

Next Steps

Construction is anticipated to begin in the summer and take approximately two years to complete. Once a contract is in place, more information about construction will be communicated.
