Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and engineering consultant Armstrong Glen, P.C. have acquired all easements needed for construction. Necessary permits, final design plans and specifications are underway and will be finalized in the next several months.

Next Steps

Next is the bid phase. During this phase the final plans are circulated to qualified contractors for a competitive bidding process. Once City Council awards the contract, construction will begin.
