Lincoln Heights Storm Drainage Improvement Project

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services held its third public meeting on August 15 at Beatties Ford Road Library to present the proposed improvements and begin the easement acquisition phase.

- Steven McCraney introduced the project team, explained the project history and summarized the project phases.
- Russell Parker, Armstrong Glen Project Engineer, presented the existing conditions and recommended improvements.
- Mr. McCraney explained the design progress and the beginning of the easement acquisition process which allows the City access to property during construction and for future maintenance.
